I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.





Where there is charity and love, God is always there. We have gathered in this place, joining hearts in love and praise, Giving thanks to God above, We go out to serve in love.






